Dear Friends of LifeNet,

Our Third LifeNet gathering in this time of transformation and upheaval in 2012 and beyond provides a challenge for us in our efforts to help in the birthing a new culture. The earth is changing, we are part of the change and we are co-creating the change. This gathering is a space for inspiration, recharging, deepening connections with ourselves and other beings, activating our visions into manifestation. Emerson College gives us an incredible resource of very willing elemental beings, because we are ready to work with them. Trees, water, hills, valleys, they are all waiting for us, to share with us the creative threads behind the visible reality. Together we will be tuning in to creative forces. Enriched with these experiences, we will be equipped to transform them into the basis of a new geaculture.

At the last gathering in 2010 we were familiarising ourselves with the concept of geaculture. We understood how important it is to stay connected and work individually to expand this concept in our home environment.

In this conference we will share our actual experiences and deeds in this realm so that in the sharing we can get a bigger picture of where we are and what is actually happening in the multidimensional layers of the earth cosmos. We want to give a further impulse or signal to this world of our willingness to make further steps into this process of co-creation. It is also a chance to co-create with each other, as a whole and in smaller group activities.

### **Who is invited**

This meeting is for those of you who are working with the landscape and its multidimensional reality. We want to build on our experience and create new ideas and visions. It is also open to others who feel connected to the LifeNet impulse.

### **Emerson College**

Emerson College provides a unique setting for our gathering in the rolling hills of Sussex not far from London. It has a long history of accommodating all kinds of conferences, groups and courses. It is the home of a Biodynamic College, the Vibella Water Research Institute, Emerson Visual Arts and the School of Story Telling. In the vicinity there is a rich variety of landscape experience on farms, rivers, churches, even the Meridian Line and a transition village as well as established alternative communities.

### **Programme**

Our work will happen mainly in the landscape in smaller and larger groups through meditation, conversation, art and other creative forms. There will be time for initiatives and sharing special projects or interests. On Saturday we will have a whole day excursion to London as it prepares for the 2012 Olympics. We will experience aspects of the city landscape temple.

### **Co-creation**

We want to build the meeting together as a whole and in groups, developing the theme and what it means for us in 2012. We are looking for people who will help with group focussing, sharing initiatives, taking groups into the landscape, translation, IT help, drivers, singers, musicians, artists and more. Please indicate your willingness to help on the booking form.

**Time Frame**

Registration is from 2 pm on Wednesday 27 June 2012. The programme starts at 5 pm with meeting Emerson co-workers and a tour of the grounds. There will be a light meal at 6.30 pm and the evening programme starts at 8 pm. We finish after lunch on Sunday 1 July.

**Accommodation**

Accommodation will be at Emerson College and in the locality. You have the choice of rooms, dormitory or camping. The meals are vegetarian and some special diets can be catered for.

**Children**

Children are welcome and parents are asked to be responsible for their children at all times. If you wish to bring children, please let us know and we will send details.

**Language**

The meeting will be in English with translation into German and other languages as required.

**Registration**

Emerson College will take on the work of handling booking and registration. This is a big help with the administration.

**Fees**

Fees include the cost of the conference and meals including supper on 27<sup>th</sup> June to lunch on 1st July. Cost of accommodation varies according to whether it is a single or double room, shared room or camping. See the booking form for details. Please make payment to Emerson College.

**Booking deadline**

Last date for booking and payment of fees is 1 April 2012. Availability of accommodation cannot be guaranteed after this date. There is a reduction in price if you book before 31 January 2012 – the fee with meals is £212 (plus accommodation). After the 31 January it is £237 (plus accommodation). Please make sure the bank transfers the exact amount in Pounds Sterling. You can save bank charges if you pay by credit card. Details are on the booking form.

**Help with costs**

**Cancellation**

If you need to cancel, please do this in writing to Emerson College. For cancellations received by 30<sup>th</sup> April 2012, an administration fee of £50 will be deducted before repayment; after that date, no repayment will be made.
